Resolution 2006-02

A Resolution to amend the monthly service rate structure and the rates charged for sewer service provided by the District to all customers

- Whereas, the District has experienced a considerable amount of growth in the demand for sewer service as the population has grown and the number of residential and commercial customers has increased during the last decade since its last rate amendment; and
- Whereas, the costs of production and delivery of municipal sewer services and the costs of operation and maintenance of the municipal sewer system have increased dramatically over this period, particularly those costs related to energy and with increasing regulation; and
- Whereas, the current sewer rates charged by the District do not cover the District's expenses to operate the District's sewer system; and
- Whereas, during the calendar year 2005, the Board's appointed Ad Hoc Sewer Rate Study Committee, including citizen consumers, met to study and review the current sewer rate formulation and its monthly rate, and did report to the Board its recommended amendments to the rate structure and monthly rates, which recommendations were then accepted by this Board; and
- Whereas, the District's Board of Trustees held public hearings regarding increasing the sewer rate on February 15, 2006, March 15, 2006, and May 18, 2006 at the conclusion of the public hearings the Board selected the following rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Indian Hills General Improvement District Board of Trustees that the sewer rates recommended by the Ad Hoc Sewer Rate Study Committee are herewith adopted, and beginning with the effective date, to wit: the sewer service monthly rate structure is changed to \$23.54 per month for residential customers, with a possible further rate increase up to \$2.00 each year over the next three years as determined by a vote of the Board of Trustees. Commercial establishments which discharge a residential-equivalent standard wastewater quality will be charged a flat rate of \$23.54 per EDU per month of sewer service provided, with a possible further rate increase up to \$2.00 each year over the next three years, as determined by a vote of the Board of Trustees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the effectiveness date of this amended structure and rate shall be June 1, 2006 with the first billing to customers based on this new formulation being those bills sent out after July 1, 2006.
