## Resolution 2004-02

A Resolution to encourage the Douglas County Commission and the East Fork Fire and Emergency District to proceed with the planned re-evaluation by the Insurance Service Office for the purpose of up-grading the ISO ratings applicable to the District area.

Whereas.

the Indian Hills General Improvement District (the District) has functioned successfully for 30 years as a multi-purpose unit of local government with responsibilities including the provision of safe streets, and sufficient public parks and recreation facilities to a steadily and rapidly growing number of residents, and particularly including the provision of a high quality, high-volume municipal water system, with sufficient fire hydrants and ample fire flows, to a growing number of residences and commercial establishments in the District and the surrounding area; and

- Whereas, the District's resident tax payers have contributed and continue to contribute to the several funding streams which afford the development and provision of public services, among them the provision of fire protection and emergency medical and ambulance services, both within the District and surrounding area as well as across the entirety of Douglas County; and
- Whereas, there has been collected for a number of years a specific and designated amount of tax funds the use of which includes the planned construction and operation of a new Fire and Emergency Station, on lands provided now through an agreement with the federal Bureau of Land Management (BLM), and situated alongside North Sunridge Drive and serviceable by the District's water system; and
- Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the East Fork Fire and Emergency District have recently confirmed their intentions to move forward with the construction of that significant North Sunridge facility, and have requested an Insurance Service Office (ISO) classification and rating re-evaluation, in part, on the basis of having that new facility under construction and with intentions to fully staff it when completed;
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Indian Hills General Improvement District Board of Trustees that the Douglas County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Trustees of the East Fork Fire and Emergency District, are

encouraged to proceed with the requested and scheduled ISO re-evaluation for classification ratings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District is fully committed to working with the East Fork Fire and Emergency District and the Insurance Services Office personnel toward completing the planned re-evaluation which can, hopefully, improve the ratings and which might result in reduced costs of fire insurance premiums for District properties.
